New Business:

<u>Medford Square Survey Proposals –</u> SubCommittee just met prior to this meeting and have come to a decision on the preferred vendor. Recommendation will be made to Medford and the MHC in a few days.

Woods Bridge Wayside -_We intend to hire someone to pull together a Form B for the site adjacent to the Woods Memorial Bridge.

<u>Cradock Bridge Granite</u> – Not started yet. R. Hayward spoke to Mayor, but there is no plan to get the pieces of granite from the demo to a storage space and later brought to the River bank close to the Bridge. Suanna will speak to DCR to see if the ball can be moved forward.

Community Day Plan, Sunday, Sept. 21 1-4pm at Medford Riverbend Park, behind the McGlynn School. Three large maps of Medford with 3 different years – 1875 & 1900 & 1936 Sandborn – the concept is to have a current map to stick a flag where their house is. Post 1900, there will a separate map.. G. Pineo and J. Kossuth will prep maps. House on Streecar Surburb and Wifi.

<u>West Medford Form B Surveys</u> – Last month, a discussion was had that there was an agreement on the results of the West Medford Survey. We need to come up with the boundaries based on the Form B's to see if an area is viable. A National Register District would be the ultimate goal. First step is to define the area for possible NR listing. Please review West Medford Survey and come prepared to discuss at next month's meeting.
